8 YR OLDS: 01ST NOVEMBER 2023

Born between 01st September 2015 and 31st August 2016

9 YR OLDS: 02ND NOVEMBER 2023

Born between 01st September 2014 and 31st August 2015



GAME FORMAT: 8 YR OLD

HIGH 5 RULES

- Players will compete in the 5v5 format. WA/WD is removed which in turn will allow the GS/GK to cover the same area as GA/GD
- Unlimited rolling subs
- Max 10 players per squad
- Normal netball rules apply (footwork, obstruction, contract, scoring etc) please find a copy of the rules attached.

GAME FORMAT: 9, 10 & 11 YR OLD

7 ASIDE RULES

- Teams shall consist of 7 players. There must be at least 5 players, one of whom must play centre, to enable the fixture to go ahead.
- Substitutions can only be made at halftime or when a player is injured. There is no limit to the number of substitutions that a team can make.
- Max 10 players per squad
- Normal netball rules apply (footwork, obstruction, contract, scoring etc) please find a copy of the rules attached.

GAME RULES

- The court will be divided into 3 sections, with each player holding a specific position on the court.
- If a player moves into a position that they shouldn't be in, they will be deemed to be offside.
- Players cannot hold the ball for more than three seconds.
- Players may lift their landing foot but not reground it to contravene the footwork rule.
- The ball must go through the ringed hoop for a goal to be given.
