HOW TO REGISTER?

- If you haven't created an account already, please do so by clicking [Dubai School Games Parent Portal](#) and registering your child.
- To enter your child please click on the **INDIVIDUAL EVENTS ENTRIES** tile and Select **GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS**.
- Select the **PARTICIPANTS NAME** who you would like to take part.
- You will receive a confirmation of entry email from the Dubai Schools Games team.
- In the days prior to the championship, you will receive an email with all the details for the championship.



GAME FORMAT

- **FORMAT:** INDIVIDUAL STABLEFORD
- **NUMBER OF PLAYERS:** 80
- **REQUIREMENTS:** EGF NUMBER REQUIRED
- **START TIME:** EVERY 10 MINUTES



SCORING SYSTEM

Stableford points system will be used for scoring. It is a way to score golf that calculates the points earned on each hole. The benefit of this system is that if you get a high score on one hole, it does not ruin your entire game. You can still make up points again on the next hole.

The scoring system is also based on each player's handicap, the system is designed to reward how well you play against your own ability. The goal is to score the maximum number of points.

Points will be awarded as follows:

- 6 points – Four strokes under
- 5 points – Three strokes under
- 4 points – Two strokes under
- 3 points – One stroke under
- 2 points – Level par
- 1 point – One stroke over
- 0 points – Two strokes or more over



RULES

- A player's handicap will be determined as per the Emirates Golf Federation rules. Click [here](#) for more.
- Each player will receive a Handicap Allowance of 25% of their Full Handicap.
- The number of points awarded on each hole is determined by the number of strokes taken to par before being adjusted about the player's handicap.
- To do this, it involves taking a look at the stroke index on the scorecard.
- For example, a player with a playing handicap of eight will be afforded an extra shot on the holes that have a stroke index of one to eight. A player with a playing handicap of fourteen would get two extra strokes on holes with a stroke index of one to five and one extra shot on those with a stroke index of six to nine
