### **AGE CATEGORY**

The age group is set in the following manner:

- U11 Born between 01st September 2012 to 31st August 2014
- U13 Born between 01st September 2010 to 31st August 2012
- U15 Born between 01st September 2008 to 31st August 2010
- U17 Born between 01st September 2006 to 31st August 2008

<u>Maximum Entries</u> - Each player shall be allowed to participate in a maximum of 2 (TWO) events per age group.



### **RULES**

- The tournament will follow the <u>BWF Tournament Rules and Regulations</u> except for clothing and regulations specifically mentioned.
- At 10 all, the side that gains the next point, wins the game.
- Every time there is a service, there will be a point scored unless there is a let.

#### • <u>Intervals:</u>

- Not exceeding 120 seconds between each game
- Not exceeding 60 seconds in the final game when the leading score reaches 6
  points.

#### Change of ends

- At the end of the first game
- At the end of the second game if there is a third game
- In the third game when the leading score reaches 6 points first.



### **FAULTS**

- If in serving, the shuttlecock is struck above the server's waist.
- If at the service, the shuttlecock falls into the wrong receiving court.
- If the server's and receiver's feet are not within the boundaries of their serving court and receiving court, respectively.
- If a player touches the net with his/her racquet, person, or clothes.
- If the shuttlecock is struck in return before it has crossed the net to his/her side.

  (The follow-through may break the plane of the net.)



## **SINGLES**

- At the beginning of the game (0-0) and when the server's score is even, the server serves from the right service court. When the server's score is odd, the server serves from the left service court.
- If the server wins a rally, the server scores a point and then serves again from the alternate service court.
- If the receiver wins a rally, the receiver scores a point and becomes the new server. They serve from the appropriate service court left if their score is odd, and right if it is even.
