A maximum of 100 participants can register for this championship. Registrations will automatically close once we reach full capacity or on **Wednesday 12th February 2025,** whichever comes sooner.

AGE CATEGORY & REGISTRATION CRITERIA

- U8 Boys & Girls: Born between 2016-01-01 and 2017-12-31
- U10 Boys & Girls: Born between 2014-01-01 and 2015-12-31
- U12 Boys & Girls: Born between 2012-01-01 and 2013-12-31
- U14 Boys & Girls: Born between 2010-01-01 and 2011-12-31
- U16 Boys & Girls: Born between 2008-01-01 and 2009-12-31

To participate, the athlete must be Level 4 (minimum):

- Can control take off and land on a small jump
- Can use the poles my poles properly
- Can make an emergency stop with the proper Alpine Basic position.
- Can make a long turn on a black run, controlling my speed and using my poles.
- Can make a short turn on a black run, controlling my speed and using my poles properly.



HOW TO REGISTER?

- If you haven't created an account already, please do so by clicking <u>Dubai School</u>
 <u>Games Parent Portal</u> and registering your child.
- To enter your child please, add him/her to **Athletes** by entering the required information.
- Once added, click on the Individual Event Entries tile and Select Skiing Championship.
- Select the **Participants Name** whom you would like to take part.
- Enter required information and submit registration.
- You will receive a registration confirmation email from the Dubai Schools Games team.



Rules & Regulations

GS in Alpine Ski Racing (Giant Slalom):

In alpine skiing, GS refers to Giant Slalom, a type of race that involves skiers navigating a set of gates placed farther apart compared to slalom events. Some of the general rules and regulations for GS races include:

- 1. Course Layout: The course is composed of a series of gates (flags) that skiers must pass between. The gates are placed at wider intervals compared to slalom courses, and racers must turn around the poles.
- 2. Race Format: Races generally consist of two runs, with the total time from both runs determining the winner. If a skier fails to complete a run, they are disqualified.
- 3. Timing: Timing is measured to the hundredth of a second. In case of a tie, the tied skiers are awarded the same position.
- 4. Equipment Requirements: Skiers must use appropriate GS skis, which are generally longer and have specific characteristics suited for highspeed turns. Helmets and other protective gear are required.
- 5. Gate Violations: Missing or incorrectly passing a gate leads to disqualification. Gates are typically marked by two poles with flags.
- 6. Start Order: The start order is usually determined by a random draw or seeding based on prior race results.
