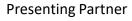

#### **HOW TO REGISTER?**

- To enter your child please click on the INDIVIDUAL EVENTS ENTRIES tile and Select GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP.
- Select the **PARTICIPANT'S NAME** who you would like to take part.
- You will receive a confirmation of entry email from the Dubai Schools Games team.
- In the days prior to the championship, you will receive an email with all the details for the championship.



## **GAME FORMAT**

• FORMAT: INDIVIDUAL STABLEFORD

• NUMBER OF PLAYERS: 48

• **REQUIREMENTS: GRINT** (GHAP NUMBER REQUIRED)

**EGF** (GHIN NUMBER REQUIRED)

• **START TIME:** EVERY 8 MINUTES



#### **SCORING SYSTEM**

Stableford points system will be used for scoring. It is a way to score golf that calculates the points earned on each hole. The benefit of this system is that if you get a high score on one hole, it does not ruin your entire game. You can still make up points again on the next hole.

The scoring system is also based on each player's handicap, the system is designed to reward how well you play against your own ability. The goal is to score the maximum number of points.

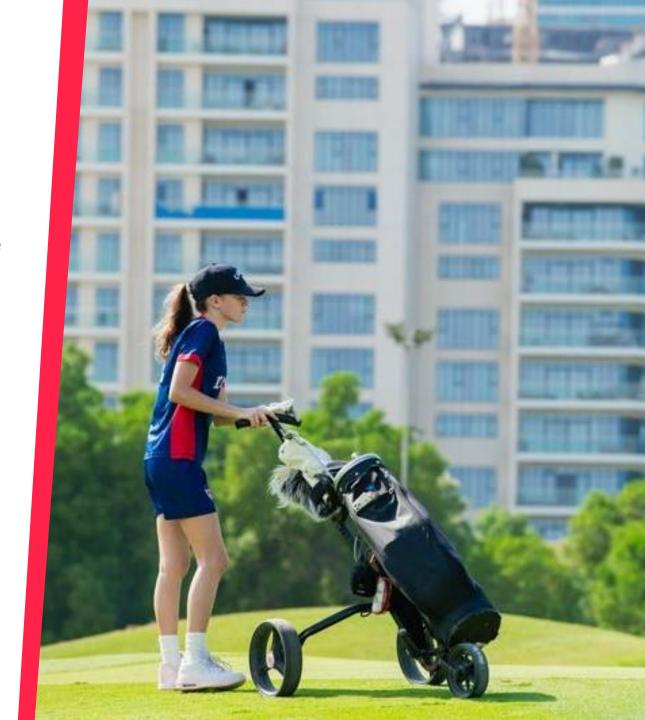
Points will be awarded as follows:

	Stroke	Do Not Stroke
EAGLE	5 Points	4 Points
BIRDIE	4 Points	3 Points
PAR	3 Points	2 Points
BOGEY	2 Points	1 Point
DOUBLE BOGEY	1 Point	0 Point
TRIPLE BOGEY	0 Point	0 Point



#### **RULES**

- Each player will receive an on-course handicap determined by their GHIN/GHAP Handicap.
- For example: if the players handicap is 9 and the stroke index of the hole is more than 9 they will "not stroke" on that hole and receive 2 points for a par. If the stroke index of that hole is 9 or lower they will "stroke" and receive 3 points for a par.
- To do this, it involves taking a look at the stroke index on the scorecard. For the Stablefordpoints breakdown, please view previous page.
- Scoring will be done on both the hardcopy scorecards as well as Golf Genius
  App.
