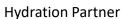

PARTICIPATION RULES

- Each school can enter 1 team in each age category.
- Each school can enter a maximum of 12 participants in each age category (12 Boys & 12 Girls).
- Eligible ages: 10 17 years
- Minimum age: Athletes must be born on or before 31 Aug 2015 (turning 10 by 1 Sep 2025).
- Maximum age: Athletes must be born on or after 1 Sep 2007 (not yet 18 on 1 Sep 2025).
- Maximum of 2 athletes per event.
- Athletes can be registered in a maximum of 2 individual events + 1 relay within their respective age group
- Registrations will close on Thursday, 23rd October 2025.



Event Timing & Overlap Instructions

- Athletes must arrive at least 15 minutes before their scheduled event.
- If an athlete is scheduled for a track and field event at the same time:
 - o They must register their name at the field event first.
 - Then complete their track event.
 - o Return to the field event within 20 minutes to continue participation
- If an athlete fails to register at the field event and the slot closes, it is not the responsibility of the organizers. The athlete will lose their chance to participate, and it will be recorded as a no-show.
- It is the responsibility of the coach and athlete to ensure they are on time. Missed events will not be rescheduled and will count as a no-show.
- It is the responsibility of coaches and athletes to listen to all announcements. In case of delays or changes in schedule, updates will be made via public announcements at the venue.



Track and Field Event Guidelines

- All track events are timed.
- Qualification and rankings are based strictly on time, not heats or positions.
- False Start Rule:
 - · Athletes who commit a false start will be given one warning.
 - A second false start results in disqualification from that event.
- Max 3 attempts per athlete for long jump and javelin.
- High Jump:
 - o 3 total fouls allowed across all heights
 - Athletes must jump at the height set by the referee at the time of their arrival. No special height adjustments will be made.



CODE OF CONDUCT

- Coaches must not interfere with referee decisions on track or field.
- Coaches must not intervene during the event to raise complaints.
- All concerns must be directed only to the Meet Director, Mohammed Sinan, either:
 - o In person at the track, or
 - o Via email to Dubai Schools Games info@dubaischoolsgames.ae
- Coaches are responsible for ensuring athletes maintain best behaviour throughout the event.
- Any form of misconduct by athletes will result in direct disqualification of the school.
- Misconduct will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- Coaches and athletes are not allowed to ask for results during or after the event.



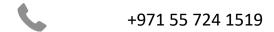
COMMUNICATION AND QUALIFICATION RESULTS

- All official results will be sent directly to each school via email after the competition.
- Top 8 athletes per event qualify for finals.
- Top 12 athletes qualify in:
 - o 1000m
 - o 1500m
- The Midea DSG Athletics Championships for those who qualify for the finals will take place on 19th–20th November 2025 at the Dubai Police Officers Club.
