Group and Knockout Stages depending on participant numbers. In case low entry Robin format

TIME: **9 AM onward**

A maximum of 60 participants (within all weapons and age categories) can register for this championship. Registrations will automatically close once we reach full capacity or on Sunday 18th January 2026, whichever comes sooner.

HOW TO REGISTER?

Rules & Regulations

1- Tournaments for players under 10 and 12 years old the sword size shall be 0-2 only (MINI).2- Individual tournaments for under 10s will be held using a group round-robin system (5 touches per match) in three minutes for the preliminary rounds, with 100% of players advancing to the knockout rounds. Play will then begin using a knockout system according to the number of players qualifying from (10 touches for players under 10 years old, match duration 6 minutes divided into two rounds, with a one-minute break between each round in the Foil and Epee, unless otherwise required by the rules of the game. In the semi-finals, there is a one-minute break (after one of the players reaches 5 points for players under 10 years old)until the semi-finals are played, with the winners qualifying for the final and the losers in the semi-finals being

Rules & Regulations

3 - Individual tournaments for the stages (12-10-14) will be held using a group league system (5 touches per match) in 3 minutes for the preliminary rounds, and the following will be excluded:

Competition and penalty system

- **20%: in the case of less than 30 players participating, with fractions rounded up to the nearest wholenumber.**
- **30%: in the case of more than 30 players participating, with fractions rounded down to the nearest wholenumber.**
- **According to their ranking after calculating the results of the preliminary rounds, play then begins with a knockout system according to the number of players qualifying from 15 touches. The duration of the match is 9 minutes divided into three rounds, with a one-minute break between each round in the Foil and Epee, unless the rules of the game dictate otherwise.**

In the semi-finals, there is a one-minute break(after one of the players reaches 8 points). The winners qualify for the final, and the losers in the semi-finals are ranked third and third again according to their ranking in the knockout table.

Fencer Equipment Responsibility

All fencers are personally responsible for arriving with complete, safe, and fully functioning equipment. Only approved equipment meeting FIE and safety standards may be used.

Mandatory Personal Equipment

Fencing jacket – minimum **350N**

Under-plastron – minimum **800N**

Breeches – minimum **350N**

Mask – minimum **350N**

Chest protector

Glove – no holes or scratches

Fencing socks – must fully cover the leg below the breeches

Weapons & Electrical Equipment

1 complete electric weapon (foil, épée, or sabre)

1 body wire

All equipment must be in working order and compliant with competition regulations.
