AGE CATEGORIES:	U9, U11 & U13 TO U16 (Girls & Boys)
MATCH FORMAT:	7/10 Points Super Tie Break
RACKET SIZE:	RED: 23 Inch Racket GREEN & HARD BALLS: 27 Inch Racket



RULES - U9 CATEGORY

- Teams of 4 players
- Each player must be ranked from 1 to 4 and will not be allowed to change their ranking, each school should register at least 1 female player in each team.
- If a team fails to register at least 1 female player in their team, the team will not qualify for the knockout rounds.
- Schools can register 2 main teams & 2 reserve teams based on first come first served basis.
- Matches will be 1 tie-break to 7 points, there will be a sudden death at 6 at all in the round robin. Must be 2 points clear to win at 6 all in the knockout stages.



RULES - U11 CATEGORY

- Teams of 4 players
- Each player must be ranked from 1 to 4 and will not be allowed to change from their ranking.
- Each school should register at least 1 female player in the team.
- If a team fails to register at least 1 female player in their team, the team will not qualify for the knockout rounds.
- Schools can register 2 main teams & 2 reserve teams based on a first come first served basis.
- The round-robin phase of the event will be tie-breaks to 10 points each, with a deciding point at 9 all.
- The knockout phases will be tie-breaks to 10 points, matches must be won by being 2 points clear.
- In the event of 2 all after 3 matched have been played, a mixed doubles game will be played by a pair chosen by the manager.



RULES - U13 to U16 CATEGORY

- Teams of 4 players per school per age group.
- Each player must be ranked from 1 to 4 and will not be allowed to change their ranking, each school should register at least 1 female player in each team.
- If a team fails to register at least 1 female player in their team, the team will not qualify for the knockout rounds.
- Schools can register 2 main teams & 2 reserve teams based on first come first served basis.
- The round robin phase of the event will be tie-breaks to 10 points each, with a deciding point at 9 all.
- The knockout phases will be tie-breaks to 10 points, matched must be won by being 2 points clear.
- Semi-finals and finals will be best of 3 sets, tie break to 7 points. No deciding point, matched must be won by being 2 points clear.

- **U9** - Born between 01st September 2016 to 31st August 2018
- **U11** - Born between 01st September 2014 to 31st August 2016
- **U13 - U16** - Born between 01st September 2012 to 31st August 2009

TOURNAMENT DATES

- **U9 Category** - 31st March 2026
- **U11 Category** - 1st April 2026
- **U13 & U16 Category** - 2nd April 2026
